

CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of Study

The topic of this thesis is a literary on a novel entitled *Cinderella Man* to reveal the American Value represent in the main character. Reason why the writer interested on the topic is because the novel as the main source tells about a true story and the way main character struggle to defend values in his life.

Analysis in this thesis based on Structuralism criticism analysis, which can be defined as a way of thinking that every human's activities are constructed. Structuralism put a strong attention to the importance of the systems of convention. In other word, it can be said that system is more important than individual utterance (Rice, Waugh, 1996: 22-23).

After a series of study, the writer sees that one of the simplest ways to find out or to discover a meaning of a literary work is that by seeing the structure and elements within the story. Consider the statement above, the writer use the Structuralism theory to analyze the novel "Cinderella Man".

The subject of this paper is a novel written by Marc Cerasini entitled “Cinderella Man”. The writer chooses this novel because it is a true story happened in American Great Depression Era (1929-1941), which promote human abilities to struggle toward a hard life, which can affect other people’s life even though in the hardest situation. Besides that, the writer also wants to analyze the idea of Traditional American Values represent in “Cinderella Man” from the point of view of James J. Braddock. 1.2 Problem Formulation
